### **GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION**

1. The poster presentation is open to undergraduate and postgraduate students, faculty, and researchers in medical and allied health sciences.
2. Each participant is allowed to present only one poster as first author, with a maximum of three co-authors permitted.
3. Abstracts must be submitted online before the deadline and should be 250–300 words in a structured format.
4. Only original work is accepted; any form of plagiarism will lead to immediate disqualification.
5. Posters must be prepared as E-posters in landscape orientation with a minimum body text font size of 24 points.
6. Mandatory poster sections include Title, Authors, Institution, Introduction, Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusion, and references if applicable.
7. Each presenter will get 5 minutes for presentation followed by 2 minutes of question-and-answer discussion.
8. The presenting author must be physically present, and proxy presentations are strictly not allowed.
9. Posters will be evaluated based on originality, scientific rigor, visual clarity, relevance to medical education, and Q&A engagement.
10. Conference registration is mandatory, and any misconduct such as plagiarism or data falsification will result in disqualification, with the committee's decision being final.

### **GUIDELINES FOR PAPER PRESENTATION**

1. The paper presentation is open to undergraduate students, postgraduate students, faculty, and researchers in medical and allied health sciences .
2. Each participant can present only one paper as first author, with a maximum of three co-authors allowed .
3. Abstracts must be submitted online before 15th January 2026 and should be 250–300 words in a structured format.
4. Submitted abstracts must be original work; plagiarism will lead to immediate disqualification .
5. Accepted abstracts will be communicated to authors via email by the organizers.
6. Papers can be submitted under categories such as Medical Education Innovations, Curriculum Development, Assessment Methods, Technology in Medical Education, Ethics, Digital Health, and Quality in Medical Education.
7. Each presenter is allotted 8 minutes for presentation followed by 2 minutes for question and answer session.
8. Presentations must be in PowerPoint or PDF format, delivered in English, and the presenter must be physically present .
9. Papers will be evaluated based on originality, scientific rigor, clarity, relevance to medical education, and engagement during Q&A.
10. Participants must be registered for the conference, follow ethical guidelines, and adhere to the final decision of the Scientific Committee
